A **new version of the elearningeuropa.info portal** has been launched. The new version is developed to simplify the service offer and to help portal users to find easier wanted and interesting information.

The new elearningeuropa.info is now based on four services: **Directory, Community, Newsletter** and **eLearning Papers**.



The e-learning **Directory** provides a wide range of e-learning materials and information sources from across Europe organised by category and interest area. There are ten categories which include currently over 4,000 items.



The e-learning **Newsletter** brings the subscribed users news about current issues, open calls, forthcoming events and e-learning resources. The newsletter is available in 19 languages and it is sent once a month.



The e-learning **Community** is a place for e-learning practitioners to discuss and debate issues and post and search for information and ideas relevant to their day-to-day tasks. The area includes forums, announcement boards, user generated interviews, contests and public profiles of the portal members.



eLearning Papers is an online publication on e-learning offering an executive summary of each article in 19 languages and the full texts in their original languages. eLearning Papers has been online since November 2006 and is the only service in the portal which has its own domain, www.elearningpapers.eu.

Together these four services aim to correspond with the different needs of the portals **24,000 registered users** and more than **50,000 monthly visitors**.

Along with the new structure the portal introduces other improvements, such as **RSS Feeds, Web 2.0 social linking tools**, area of **media partners**, **improved page loading time** and a **Frequently Asked Questions** section. Visit the portal and find out all these and many more!

Furthermore, as a registered user you can **publish your member profile** on the portal and that way provide more information about yourself. A published profile will appear in the "Members" listing and other users are able to view it. The member profile shows information about your interests in e-learning and your participation on the portal, and enables you to network with other members of the portal.
